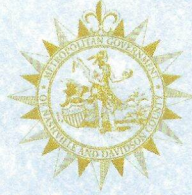

**WHEREAS**, together, we make a difference through love; and


